Introduction to Attachment, Trauma and Resilience

Teaching type: Interactive webinar delivered via Zoom

Participants: 25 staff members per webinar (3 webinars in total engaging 75 staff)

Purpose: to raise awareness and develop understanding about attachment behaviours, unregulated toxic stress, trauma and resilience, and how KCA's models Five to Thrive and Mending Hurts can support effective, connected relationships that promote recovery from trauma.
